Construction on luxury hotel underway in Boerne

Developers began construction on Monday on Boerne's new luxury hotel, The Bevy Hotel Boerne, A DoubleTree by Hilton.

Under co-developers Phoenix Hospitality Group and Partlow Properties & Investments LLC, the new 120-room boutique hotel along Boerne's South Main Street marks the first collaboration between the two companies, both of which have experience doing business in Boerne.

The new hotel at 101 Herff, The Bevy, will sit on four acres of a 20-acre plot of land owned and developed by Ross Partlow and Tim Lange of Partlow Properties along with Phoenix Hospitality Group partners Ed McClure and John Corcoran.

Cost of the project is approximately \$25 million; the hotel will open in the first quarter of 2019.

"A bevy is a collection of similar things. In the case of our hotel, this 'Bevy' embodies a cornucopia of all things Texas Hill Country: incredible diverse food; artisan beverages; authentic regional finishes; vibrant wild flowers; unique Texas music; and Texas hospitality," Partlow said in a news release. "Travelers to the Hill Country will be able to stay at The Bevy Hotel Boerne and enjoy everything that makes the Hill Country what it is, without leaving the hotel."
